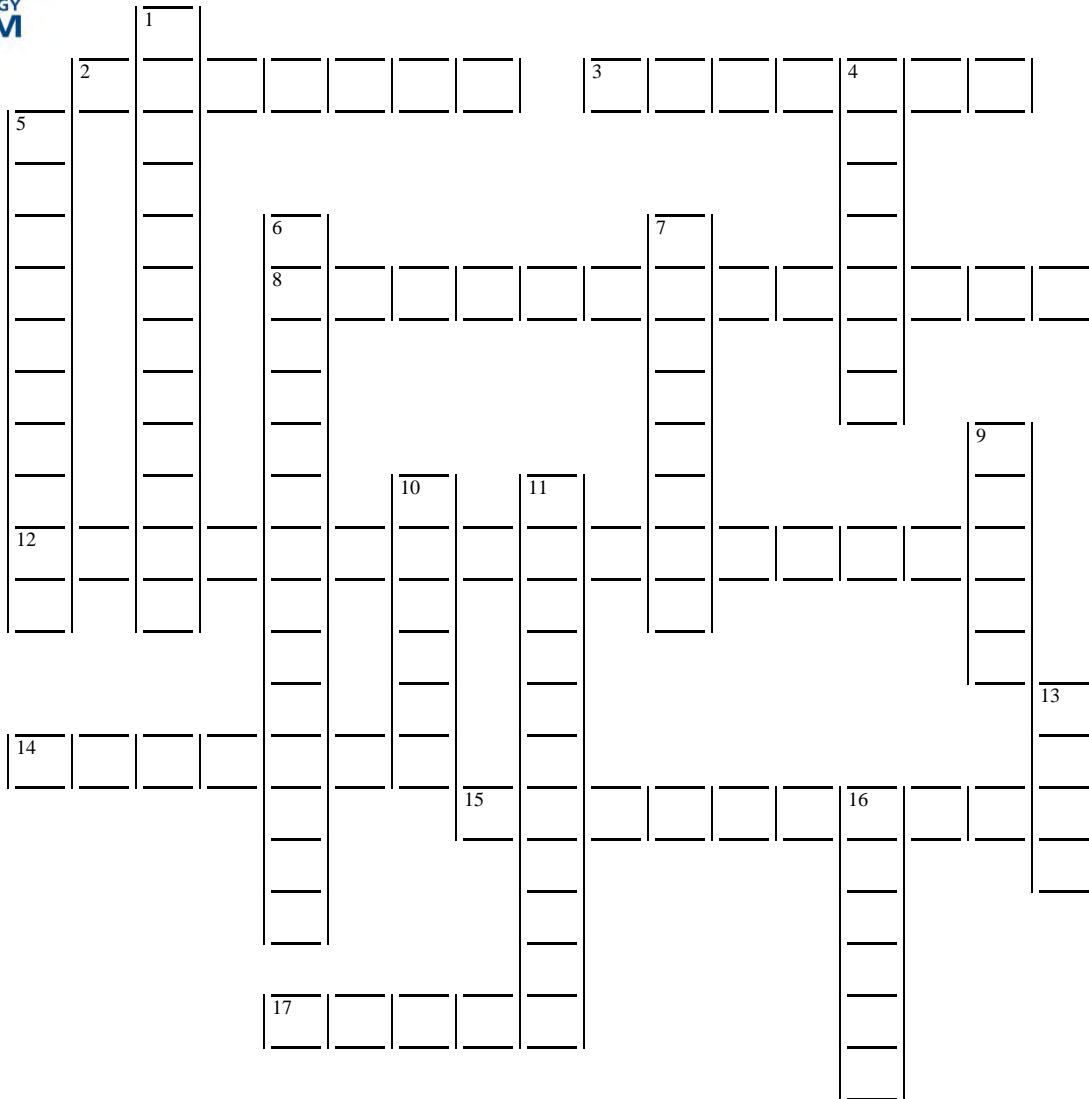




# Diversity of Life
